Artist helping Earth to win

NEWCASTLE artist Sharon Davson has just launched a major giveaway art promotion, leading up to World Environment Day on June 5.

"This is the first environmental promotion of its type," Ms Davson said.

"It will raise much-needed funds for several very worthy organisations including the Wildlife Information Rescue and Education Service, National Parks Association of NSW, Nature Conservation Council, Clean Up Australia and the Davson Arts Museum.

"The project includes five thought-provoking e-Greeting cards which can be sent to as many people as you desire – there is no limit after the small initial purchase."

That immediately qualifies e-card purchasers to go into the giveaway draw to win a unique work of art by Sharon Davson.

This framed work will incorporate an original autographed handprint by legendary Formula One world champion Sir Jack Brabham.

For much of her life, Ms Davson has dedicated time and resources to helping world peace and environmental causes, especially endangered species and disadvantaged people.

Since 1999, her art has primarily been exhibited in retrospective exhibitions in public regional art galleries.

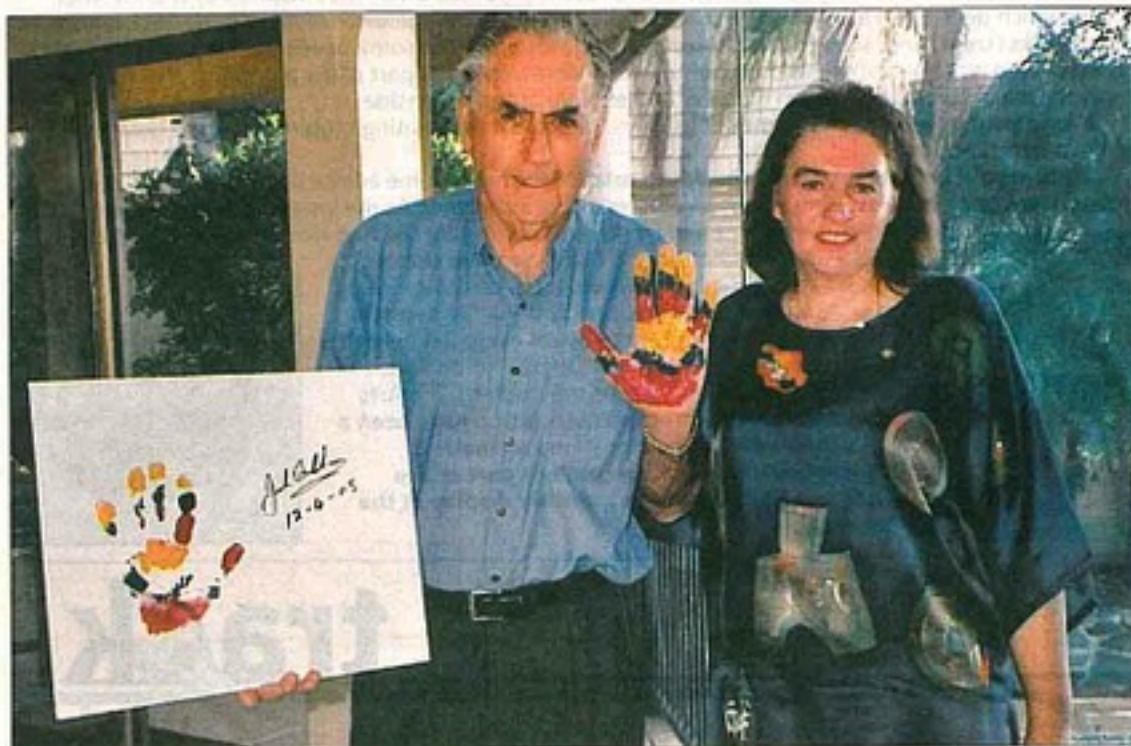
Sir Jack Brabham is a patron of Ms Davson's creative and charitable ventures.
